Guidelines for Abstract Structure

1. Introduction

Provide a brief overview of the topic and its relevance. Define the specific problem or question that your work addresses.

2. Objectives and Research Questions

Describe what you aim to achieve with your work. List the specific questions that your work answers.

3. Materials & Methods

Explain the methods and materials used to obtain the results of your work.

4. Practical Relevance

Specify the practical relevance of your work and how your results may be useful in practice in the future.

5. Results

Summarize the key findings of your research and discuss the opportunities and risks arising from them.

6. Conclusion & Outlook

Briefly comment on the practical application of your results and identify any further activities required to implement your findings in practice. Highlight what makes your work, approach, or results noteworthy or surprising.

Your abstract may be up to 2,000 characters, including spaces, and can be written in either German or English. **Important:** Submissions with incomplete or missing abstracts cannot be considered for evaluation.
